- 2. Passed The Japanese-Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N2
- 3. Achieve a score of The Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) over 200 points on Japanese.
- 4. Achieve a score of Business Japanese Proficiency Test (BJT) over 400 points.

Applicants MUST have a good enough command of Japanese to understand lectures held in Japanese at the college. To prove this, applicants must fulfill at least one of the qualifications above $(1\sim4)$.

Qualifications for Application

Applicants must fulfill all of the following qualifications (1 \sim 3).

- 1. Over 18 years old.
- 2. Applicants are required to have completed a regular course of secondary education (more than 12 years

full time) in any country and/or have qualified to apply for university of their country by the end of March of the expected year of entrance to the college.

- 3. Applicants must fulfill at least one of the following qualifications:
 - a)Have had Japanese education for 6 months or more in a Japanese language institution certified by the Ministry of Justice.
 - b) Passed The Japanese-Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N2
 - c)Achieve a score of The Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) over 200 points on Japanese .
 - d)Achieve a score of Business Japanese Proficiency Test (BJT) over 400 points.

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
